

How to access the My Ride K-12 website

1. Use the Chrome browser, myridek12.tylerapp.com.
2. If you do not have an account, click **Sign up**.
3. Then, enter your email address, password, and date of birth.
4. After you are done, you will receive an email from My Ride K-12. Click the link in the email to access the My Ride K-12 website.
5. When you log in, you will see a dashboard with various options. If you need assistance, email help@tylerapp.com.
6. If you are having trouble logging in, click the **Forgot password** link. If you need assistance, email help@tylerapp.com.
7. Once you are logged in, you can access the My Ride K-12 website.

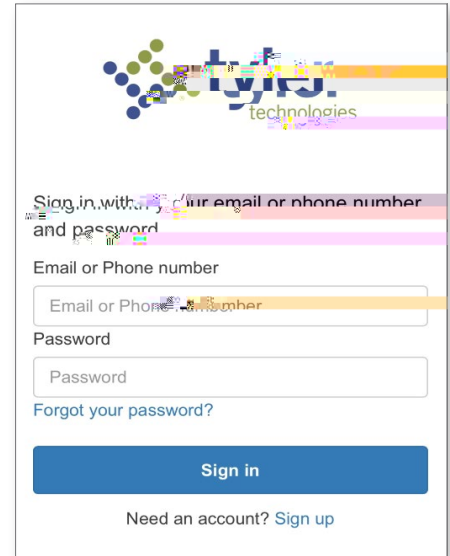


How to access the My Ride K-12 mobile application

1. Download My Ride K-12 from the Google Play Store or the Apple App Store.
2. After installation is complete, open My Ride K-12.
3. When prompted to select a district, each field will be highlighted. Click on the district you wish to use. If needed, scroll to find the district.
4. Once a district is selected, proceed to the Register screen. If you are a new user, click Register.
5. Then, enter the email address you wish to use.
6. After email is entered, enter each character of the password. Tap the eye icon to toggle visibility of the password in My Ride K-12.
7. Lastly, enter the student ID number. Tap the Add Student icon.
8. Enter the email address of the parent/guardian. Tap the eye icon to toggle visibility of the password in My Ride K-12.
9. Once a parent/guardian is added, click on the parent/guardian's name.
10. Proceed to Share button to share the QR code with the parent/guardian.
11. Enter the email address of the parent/guardian. Tap the eye icon to toggle visibility of the password in My Ride K-12, if needed. Tap the Add button to add the parent/guardian.
12. Repeat each step for each parent/guardian you wish to add.
13. Repeat the steps for each child you wish to add.
